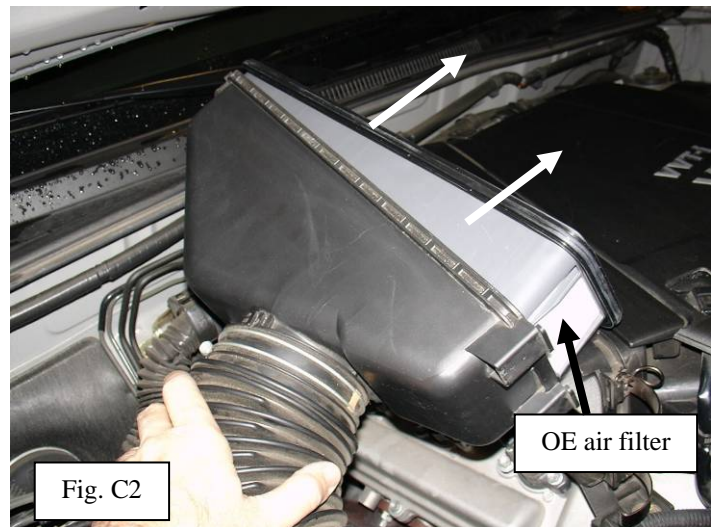
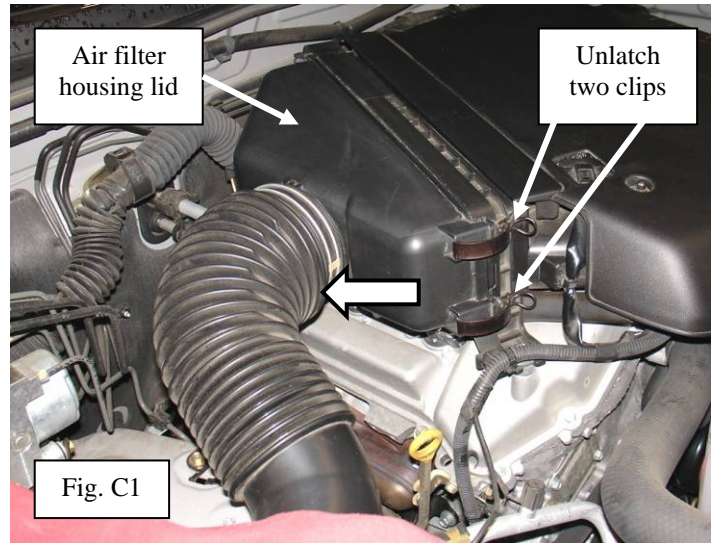
B. Vehicle Preparation



1. Use blankets to protect the front grille and passenger-side front fender area.

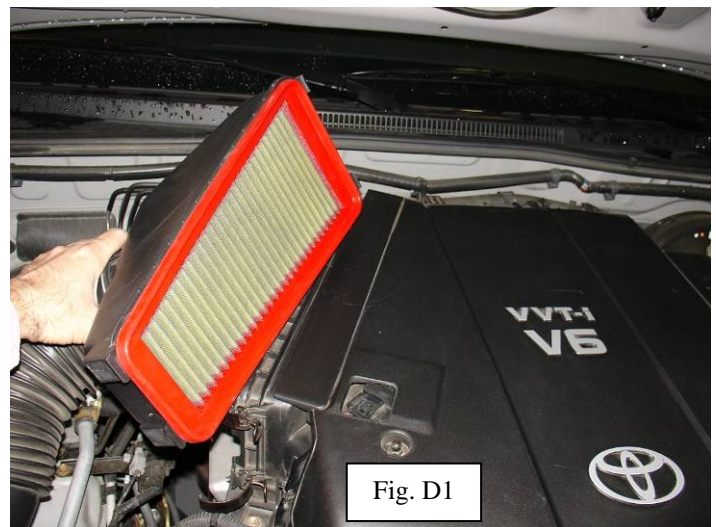
C. Removal Procedure: OE Air Filter

1. Remove the original equipment (OE) air filter.
 - i. Unlatch two front air filter housing clips. (Fig. C1)
 - ii. Move front of air filter housing lid about 1-inch away from intake manifold to expose air filter. (Block arrow, Fig. C1)
 - ➔ iii. Move air filter housing lid towards front of vehicle to disengage rear locating tabs.
 - iv. Move air filter housing lid away from assembly to expose entire air filter. (Fig. C2)
 - v. Remove OE air filter from air filter housing lid and discard filter. (Fig. C2)



D. Installation Procedure: TRD Air Filter

1. Install the TRD air filter.
 - ➔ i. Insert the TRD air filter into the air filter housing lid with the deep side of the filter into the lid. (Fig D1)
 - ➔ ii. Engage the rear locating tabs first from the lid into the housing assembly.



iii. Move front of air filter housing lid into place and re-latch two front air filter housing clips. (Fig. D2)

➔ 2. Use a lint free cloth and a Toyota approved cleaner such as 3M Prep Solvent 70 or similar to clean the air filter housing lid adjacent to the intake duct. (Fig. D2)

➔ 3. Use a lint free cloth and water to clean the same area as in Step 2 above. (Fig. D2)

⚠ 4. Apply TRD air filter warning label to area pre-cleaned from the steps above. (Fig. D3)

E. Post Installation

1. Remove blankets from front fender and grille area.
