DRIVER SIDE SET

1. Check Kit Content.

(a) Check kit for content and damage.



2. Installation Preparation.

- (a) Thoroughly clean all installation surfaces.
 - (i) Use a clean lint free cloth.
 - (ii) Clean surface thoroughly and wipe dry immediately with a new clean cloth. Do allow cleaner to air dry. (Fig. 2-1)



(b) Pillar appliqués must be between 70 F and 110 F at time of installation.



- (c) Vehicle surfaces must be between 70 F and 110 F at time of installation.
- (d) Do not touch or allow debris or contaminates to come in contact with the adhesive backing before installation.
- (e) Inspect parts prior to installation. Dry fit parts for alignment reference.







3. Install Front Door Pillar Appliqué

- (a) Using a clean water mist bottle and distilled water thoroughly mist each pillar installation area. (Fig. 3-1)
- (b) Position part over pillar to check for proper fit prior to installation.
- (c) Remove the tape liner from the pillar applicable appliqué. Do not to touch the adhesive during installation.
- (d) Align part uniformly to the top and door edge of the pillar. (Fig. 3-2)
- (e) Gently touch the part into position and reposition as necessary. Once positioned correctly apply hand pressure to ensure maximum adhesion contact.
 - (i) Press from the center of the appliqué toward the edges to remove all air bubbles.



- (f) The edge of the appliqué should be flush to the top and door edge of the pillar, (=/-2mm, no overhang).
- (g) The bottom edge alignment will vary from vehicle to vehicle due to variation in the OE molding placement. (+/- 0-4mm)

4. Install Rear Door Pillar Appliqué

- (a) Repeat steps 3(a) 3(g) on rear door pillar.(Fig. 4-1)
- 5. Repeat Sections 3 and 4 on opposite side of vehicle.

Accessory Function Checks Door Operation	The doors shall open and close without any interference from the appliqué
Vehicle Function Checks Appliqué – Adhesive Appliqué - Alignment Appliqué - Tolerances	Appliqué should be securely attached to the vehicle. Appliqué should be parallel to the edges of the vehicle door. Confirm tolerances in step 3(f) and 3(g).
