
1. Installation of Floor Net


- (a) Open vehicle rear cargo door and locate slide-out load floor release lever. Move and hold lever all the way to the right and pull tray out to its full extension. (Fig. 1-1)
- ENSURE TRAY IS LOCKED IN POSITION BEFORE CONTINUING.
- (b) If needed, place Cargo Divider Door in the up position as shown. (Fig 1-2)

(c) Orient floor net on the slide-out load floor so pull tab is laying face up on top of the net and towards the rear of the vehicle. (Fig. 1-3)



(d) Reach around the driver side edge of the Cargo Divider Door and install forward loop over the raised metal tab. (Fig. 1-4)





- (e) Pull floor net's driver side rear loop rearward and install over the rear T-anchor located on the bottom side of the slide-out load floor.
 (Fig. 1-5)
- USE BOTH HANDS AS NEEDED TO ENSURE YOU HOLD BUNGEE CORD TIGHTLY. DO NOT ALLOW IT TO RETRACT FREELY
- (f) Repeat steps 1(d) & 1(e) for the passenger side of vehicle
- (g) Completed assembly as shown. (Fig 1-6)
