





1. Install Hardware.

- (a) Open rear hatch door.
 - (1) Apply vehicle protection (blanket) to rear sill and fascia.
- (b) Locate and cut out templates (see page 5).
- (c) Tape the template to the vehicle as shown (Fig. 1-1).
- (d) Ensure the template is positioned towards the plastic trim panel edge.
- (e) Use center punch to mark the location of the hole for drilling onto the rear plastic trim panel (Fig. 1-2).
- (f) Set the drill stop on a ¹/₂" drill bit to 5 mm from the end of the drill. (Fig. 1-3).


