



- (a) NOTE: Start on right side, align and attach drill template to panel with masking tape as shown (Fig 1-1).
- (b) Center-punch the panel as indicated on the template (Fig 1-2).




(c) Carefully drill a 3.5mm hole through underlying plastic bracket (right side only) and sheet metal (Fig. 1-3). (Set Drill stop at 10 mm.)





(d) After drilling 3.5mm hole in underlying bracket/sheet metal, enlarge existing hole in trim panel using a 10mm drill bit (Fig. 1-4).


CAUTION: Drill 10mm HOLE IN OUTER PLASTIC ONLY.


NOTE: Use a drill step set at 4 mm















NOTE: Apply rust preventative to the screw tip.



- (e) Screw new anchor assembly snugly into underlying sheet metal, ensuring anchor is horizontal after installation (Fig 1-4) & (Fig 1-5).
- (f) Repeat above steps for the left side of vehicle.



- (g) Attach the loop at the top of the net to the T-anchor, making sure the pouch is on the driver's side of the vehicle (Fig 1-6).
- (h) Attach the hook at the bottom of the net to the D-ring on the floor (Fig 1-7).



(i) Completed assembly (Fig 1-8).
