These guidelines can be found in the "Accessory Installation Practices" document.

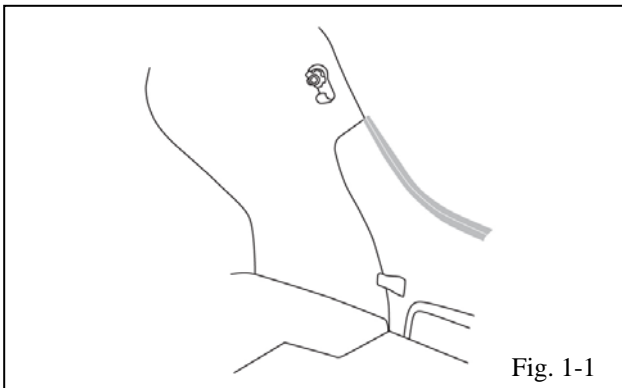
This document covers such items as:-

- Electrical Component Disassembly/Reassembly (battery disconnection, connector removal, etc.).

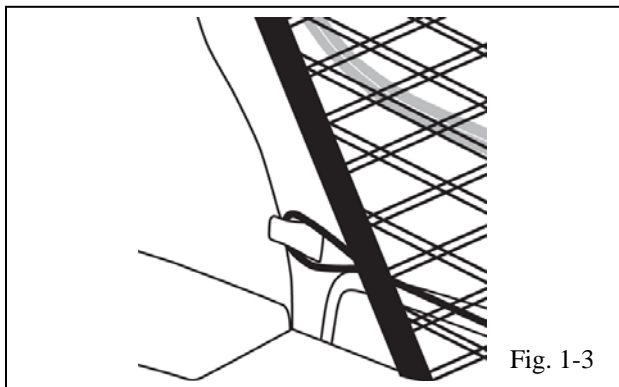
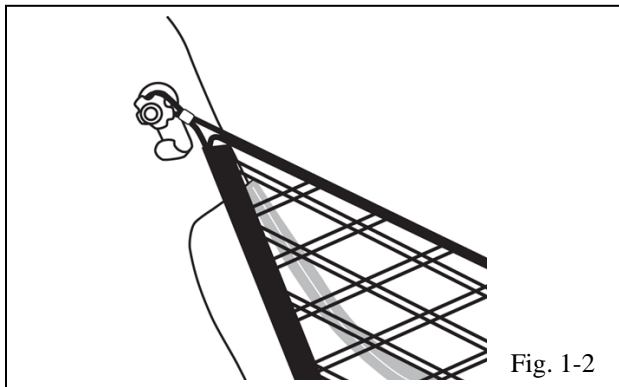

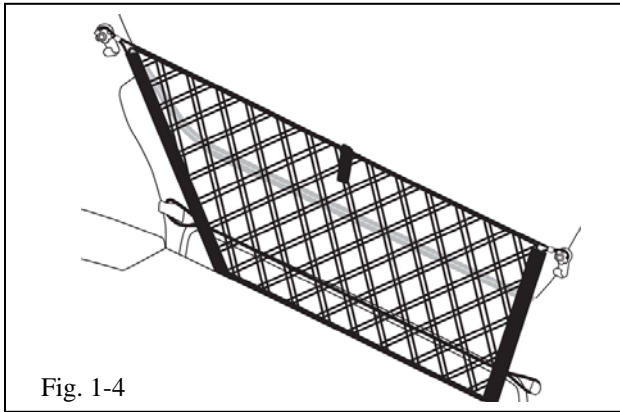


1. Installation of Cargo Net.



- (a) Open trunk, locate anchor locations on the passenger's side of the vehicle (Fig 1-1.)
- (b) Attach loop at the top of the net to the vehicle anchor as shown (Fig. 1-2).
- (c) Attach loop at the bottom of the net to the vehicle as shown (Fig. 1-3).
- (d) Repeat steps 1(a) through 1(c) for the opposite side of the vehicle.





(e) Confirm completed assembly. Make sure net handle is facing out toward the rear of the vehicle (Fig. 1-4).

Checklist - these points **MUST** be checked to ensure a quality installation.

<u>Check:</u>	<u>Look For:</u>
<p><u>Accessory Function Checks</u></p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Confirm that the net is attached properly to the anchor points in the vehicle.</p>	<p>Make sure the loops are attached to the vehicle anchors at the top and bottom. The net handle should face out toward the rear of the vehicle.</p>
<p><u>Vehicle Function Checks</u></p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Vehicle door operation</p>	<p>Confirm vehicle door open and closes without interference from Cargo Net.</p>
<p><u>Vehicle Appearance Check</u></p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> After accessory installation and removal of protective cover(s), perform a visual inspection.</p>	<p>Ensure no damage (including scuffs and scratches) was caused during the installation process. (For PPO installations, refer to TMS Accessory Quality Shipping Standard.)</p>
