


C. Removal Procedure: OE Air Filter

- 1. Remove the factory air filter.
 - Unlatch four air filter housing clips. (Fig. C1)
 - ii. Lift air filter housing lid up to expose factory air filter. (Fig. C2)
 - iii. Remove factory air filter from air filter housing and discard filter. (Fig. C2)

D. Installation Procedure: TRD Air Filter

- 1. Install the TRD air filter.
- i. Insert the TRD air filter into the air filter housing with the deep side of the filter down in the housing. (Fig D1)








- ii. Move air filter housing lid into place. (Fig. D2)


