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



1. Install the Mini Tie-Downs.


CAUTION: Do not install Mini Tie-Downs on vehicles equipped with a Tonneau Cover. <u>Damage to the Tonneau Cover may occur and</u> <u>the Tonneau Cover will not latch properly!</u>

(a) Remove (DO NOT DISCARD) the end caps from the side rails (Fig. 1-1).

(b) Push the tie-down loop so that the locking plate is equal with the guide surface (Fig. 1-2).

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- (c) With the tie-down loop depressed, slide the tie-down into the rails with the hook facing down. The tie-down must be angled to maneuver around the bed post and into the rail. Release the tie-down loop when the locking plate enters the rail (Fig. 1-3).
- (d) Slide the tie-down to the nearest detent position and snap it into place. To move it to another detent position, depress the tie-down loop and slide it to the next detent (Fig. 1-4).

- (e) Rotate the tie-down loop in a clockwise direction until it is tight (Fig. 1-5).
- (f) Repeat Step 1 for the other side.

(g) Reinstall the end caps (RH & LH) (Fig. 1-6).
