Procedure






This document covers such items as:-

- Vehicle Protection (use of covers and blankets, cleaning chemicals, etc.).
- Safety (eye protection, rechecking torque procedure, etc.).
- Vehicle Disassembly/Reassembly (panel removal, part storage, etc.).
- Electrical Component Disassembly/Reassembly (battery disconnection, connector removal, etc.).

1. Installation Preparation

(a) Open Carton and check part for damage and kit contents.

2. Vehicle Preparation.



(a) Remove and discard the pocket covers located above the armrests in the quarter trim panel. (Fig. 2-1)



(1) Use a nylon removal tool or a flat screwdriver with the tip covered with tape to to avoid damaging the panels.



(2) Using a 10mm socket, remove the panel mounting bolts (not shown) and discard.

3. Install the Panel Adapters


- (a) Install the panel adapter. (Fig. 3-1)
 - (1) The adapters are side specific and marked as such. (See back of part)





(b) Using a 5mm hex bit, install the provided M6 cap screws. Do not over-tighten.


4. Install the Cargo Cover (behind 3rd row seat)

- (a) Install the cover in the area behind the 3rd row seat.
- (b) Compress one of the end caps and install into pocket. (Fig. 4-1) (Pocket Shown in Fig. 3-1)









- (1) The protrusions at the ends of the Cargo Cover are installed between the "hooks" in the rear pockets. (Fig. 4-1)
- (2) The shade handle should be oriented towards the rear of the vehicle. (Fig. 4-2)
- (c) Compress the other end cap and install into the opposite pocket.
- (d) The drop curtain should be rolled and snap-fastened to itself. (Fig. 4-3)


5. Storage of Extensions


- (a) Place storage bag containing extensions and instructions in rear floor storage compartment. (Fig. 5-1)
 - (1) The yellow tag on the storage bag drawstring should be visible from outside the rear storage compartment.
 - (2) Simply close the compartment door on the draw string leaving the tag visible.


Installation Behind 2nd Row Seat


(For consumer use. Not to be performed by installer)

- (a) Remove extensions from storage bag located in rear floor storage compartment.(See Step 5a)
- (b) Remove cargo cover from behind 3rd row seat by compressing one end cap and swinging the cover out of the vehicle.
- (c) Make sure to remove the center mounted seat belt and store per the vehicle owner's manual.
- (d) Place an end cap extension onto the LH end cap. (Fig. 6-1)
 - (1) The extensions are identical and it does not matter which extension is used on which side.









- (e) Install the left side of the cargo cover into the LH adapter. (Fig. 6-2)
 - (1) The pull handle for the retractable cover should be towards the rear of the vehicle.
 - (2) The slot for the cover should be oriented towards the top.
- (f) Swing the cargo cover into the vehicle and place the other extension onto the RH end cap. (Fig. 6-3)
- (g) Compress the RH end cap/extension and insert it into the RH adapter.
- (h) Clip Drop Curtain to the headrests of the 2nd row seats. Simply snap the clips onto the headrest posts. (Fig. 6-4)
- (i) Pull on the handle to bring out the cargo cover. (Fig. 6-5)
- (j) Hook the ends of the shade into the J-hook configuration in the trim panel. (Fig. 6-5)
