


- Vehicle Protection (use of covers and blankets, cleaning chemicals, etc.).


1. Installation of Cargo Net.

(a) Open the trunk and locate the anchor locations on the passenger's side of the vehicle (Fig 1-1).






(b) With the net handle facing out toward the rear of the vehicle, attach the loop at the top of the net to the vehicle anchor as shown (Fig. 1-2).



- (c) Attach the loop at the bottom of the net to the vehicle as shown (Fig. 1-3).
- (d) Repeat steps 1(a) through 1(c) for the opposite side of the vehicle.





(e) Confirm the completed assembly. Make sure the net handle is facing out toward the rear of the vehicle (Fig. 1-4).
