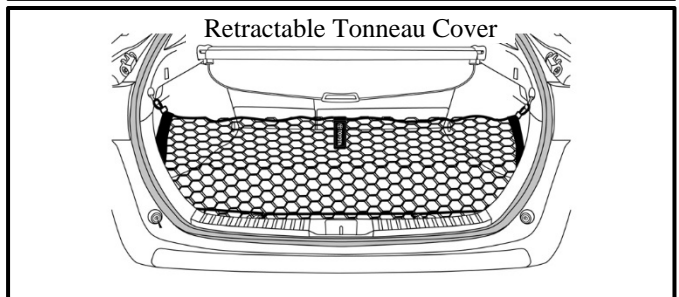
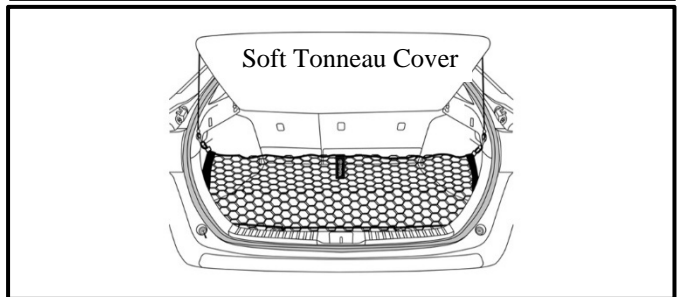
 **OPERATOR SAFETY:** Use caution to avoid risk of injury.

These guidelines can be found in the "Accessory Installation Practices" document.

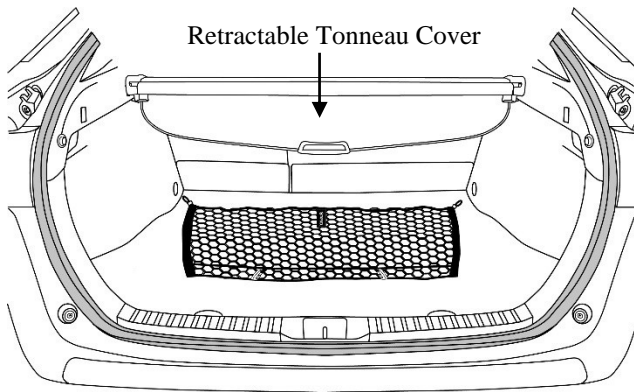
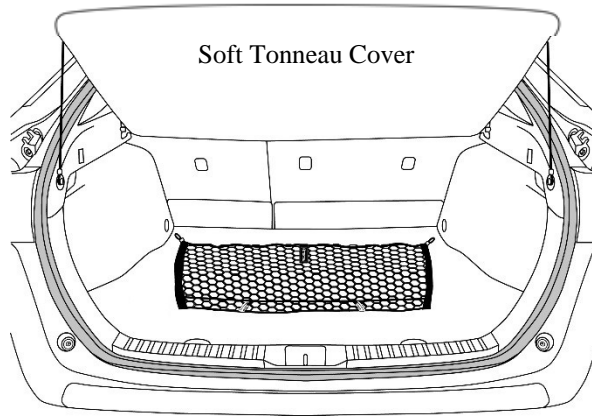
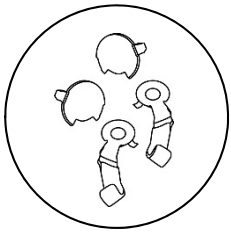
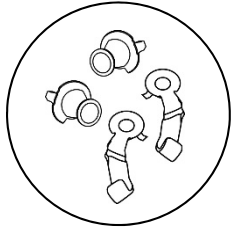
This document covers such items as:-

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Soft Tonneau Cover

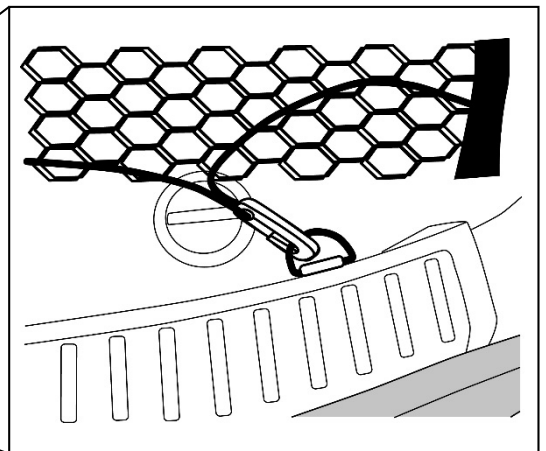
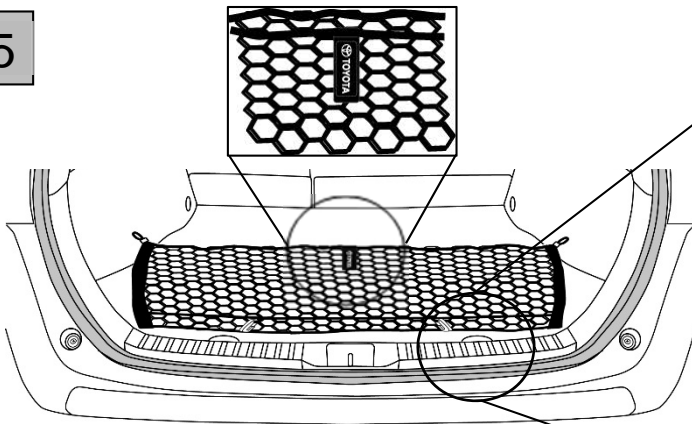


Retractable Tonneau Cover

Checklist - these points **MUST** be checked to ensure a quality installation.

Accessory Function Checks

- Confirm that the net is attached properly to the anchor points in the vehicle.

Confirm net handle is facing toward the rear of the vehicle.

Confirm upper loops at the top of the net are attached to the hooks of the vehicle.

Vehicle Function Checks

- Vehicle trunk operation

Confirm vehicle trunk opens and closes without interference from Cargo Net.

- Tonneau cover operation

Confirm tonneau cover opens and closes freely without interference from cargo net or hook.

Vehicle Appearance Check

- After accessory installation and removal of protective cover(s), perform a visual inspection.

Ensure no damage (including scuffs and scratches) was caused during the installation process. (For PPO installations, refer to TMS Accessory Quality Shipping Standard.)
