## 1. Prepare for the Installation.

(a) Thoroughly clean all the installation surfaces.



NOTE: Always use a clean, lint-free scratch resistant cloth.




NOTE: Shake the VDC cleaner well.

(b) Apply the VDC directly to cloth (Fig.1-1).



**NOTE:** Do NOT spray cleaning solutions directly to vehicle.





(c) Clean all emblem surfaces thoroughly and wipe dry immediately with a new clean cloth (Fig. 1-2).




NOTE: Do not allow cleaner to air dry.



NOTE: Emblem cap and vehicle installation surface must be between 70°F and 110°F at the time of installation.



**NOTE:** A heat source may be used to reach minimum temperature if necessary.




### 2. Check the Kit Content.

(a) Inspect the kit for content and damage (Fig. 2-1).



NOTE: Driver and Passenger side "SR5" and "Limited" emblem caps are identical.






# 3. Install the Driver Side Tacoma Emblem Cap.

NOTE: Tacoma driver and passenger side emblem caps are different and labeled to reflect. Incorrect installation will result in poor fit and incomplete badge coverage (Fig. 3-1).


- (a) Select driver side emblem cap by referring to the emblem label (Fig 3-1). Check fitment of the TACOMA emblem cap over the driver side factory chrome emblem (Fig. 3-1).
- (b) Using the pull tab, pull leftward to remove the adhesive liner from the backside of the emblem cap (Fig. 3-2).




**NOTE:** Do not touch the adhesive during installation.




(c) Position the emblem cap over the factory emblem starting from the top edge then downward, ensuring it is centered (Fig. 3-3).



(d) Visually verify that the TACOMA Emblem Cap is positioned correctly over the factory emblem and press lightly to adhere (Fig. 3-4).



- (e) Using a lint-free scratch resistant cloth, press firmly on the emblem cap from the center working outwards to the edges of the emblem cap, to ensure maximum adhesion contact (Fig. 3-5).
- (f) Repeat the procedure for the passenger Side.




# 4. Install the Limited Emblem Cap.

(a) Check the fitment of the limited emblem cap over the factory chrome emblem (Fig. 4-1).




(b) Using the pull tab, pull leftward to remove the adhesive liner from the backside of the applique (Fig. 4-2).




**NOTE:** Do not touch the adhesive during installation.




(c) Position the emblem cap over the factory emblem starting from the top edge then downward, ensuring it is centered (Fig. 4-3).



(d) Visually verify that the Limited Emblem Cap is positioned correctly over the factory emblem and press lightly to adhere (Fig. 4-4).




(e) Using a lint-free scratch resistant cloth, press firmly on the emblem cap from the center working outwards to the edges of the emblem cap, to ensure maximum adhesion contact (Fig. 4-5).



# 5. Install the SR5 Emblem Cap.


(a) Check the fitment of the SR5 Emblem cap over the factory chrome emblem (Fig. 5-1).



(b) Using the pull tab, pull leftward to remove the adhesive liner from the backside of the emblem cap (Fig. 5-2).



**NOTE:** Do not touch the adhesive during installation.




(c) Position the emblem cap over the factory emblem starting from the top edge then downward, ensuring it is centered (Fig. 5-3).




(d) Visually verify that the SR5 Emblem Cap is positioned correctly over the factory emblem and press lightly to adhere (Fig. 5-4).






# 6. Install the 4X4 Emblem Cap.

(a) Check the Fitment of the 4X4 Emblem Cap over the factory Chrome Emblem (Fig. 6-1).




(b) Using the pull tab, pull leftward to remove the adhesive liner from the backside of the emblem cap (Fig. 6-2).


**NOTE:** Do not touch the adhesive during installation.




(c) Position the Emblem Cap over the factory emblem starting from the top edge then downward, ensuring it is centered (Fig. 6-3).



(d) Visually verify that the 4X4 Emblem Cap is positioned evenly over the factory emblem and press lightly to adhere (Fig. 6-4).




(e) Using a lint-free scratch resistant cloth, press firmly on the emblem cap from the center working outwards to the edges of the emblem cap, to ensure maximum adhesion contact (Fig. 6-5).




## 7. Install the V6 Emblem Cap.

(a) Check the fitment of the V6 emblem cap over the factory chrome emblem (Fig. 7-1).



(b) Using the pull tab, pull leftward to remove the adhesive liner from the backside of the emblem cap (Fig. 7-2).


**NOTE:** Do not touch the adhesive during installation.



(c) Position the emblem cap over factory emblem starting from the top edge then downward, ensuring it is centered (Fig. 7-3).



(d) Visually verify that the V6 emblem cap is positioned correctly over the factory emblem and press lightly to adhere (Fig. 7-4).



(e) Using a lint-free scratch resistant cloth, press firmly on the emblem cap from the top working downward to the bottom of the emblem cap, to ensure maximum adhesion contact (Fig. 7-5).

# 8. Destroy/Discard the Unused Emblem Caps.

(a) The kit contains emblem caps for several trim levels, and non-applicable badge caps to be destroyed/discarded.

Checklist - these points **MUST** be checked to ensure a quality installation.

Accessory Function Checks	
Emblem cap Adhesive	Emblem cap should be securely attached to the vehicle; no air pockets or lifting.
Emblem cap alignment	Emblem cap should be properly aligned within 1mm max allowable gap from vehicle surface.
Vehicle Function Checks	
Vehicle Appearance Check	
After accessory installation and removal of protective cover(s), perform a visual inspection.	Ensure no damage (including scuffs and scratches) was caused during the installation process.  (For PPO installations, refer to TMS Accessory Quality Shipping Standard.)
Verify that all applicable emblem caps are installed.
