Care must be taken when installing this accessory to ensure damage does not occur to the vehicle. The installation of this accessory should follow approved guidelines to ensure a quality installation.


These guidelines can be found in the "Accessory Installation Practices" document.

This document covers such items as:-

- Vehicle Protection (use of covers and blankets, cleaning chemicals, etc.).
- Safety (eye protection, rechecking torque procedure, etc.).
- Vehicle Disassembly/Reassembly (panel removal, part storage, etc.).
- Electrical Component Disassembly/Reassembly (battery disconnection, connector removal, etc.).

1. Prepare for the Installation.

- (a) Open the package and check the part for damage and kit contents.
- (b) Remove any stored items and debris from trunk area.
-  (c) Place vehicle protection over the trunk and rear bumper.

2. Install the Cargo Tray.

- (a) Place the cargo tray in the trunk area with the logo towards the rear of the vehicle and facing up (Fig 2-1).

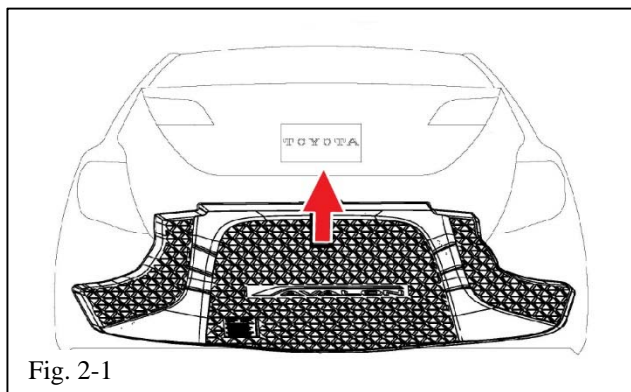

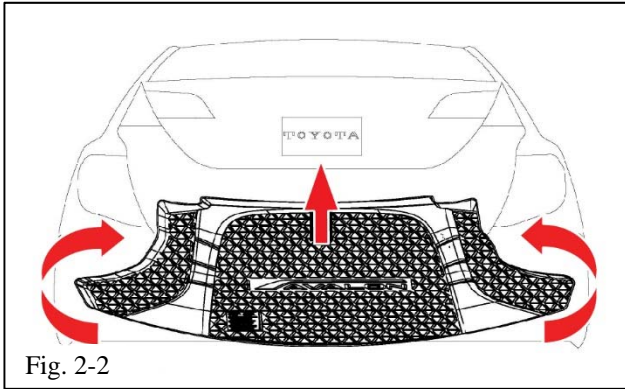

- !** (b) Grasp the tray by the sides and fold up and inward sufficiently to slide it into the rear compartment. After installing the tray, ensure all the edges are pushed down against the floor (Fig 2-2).

3. Complete the Installation.

- (a) Remove the vehicle protection.
- (b) Close the trunk door.
