Procedure


Care must be taken when installing this accessory to ensure damage does not occur to the vehicle. The installation of this accessory should follow approved guidelines to ensure a quality installation.




1. Remove Ditch Molding Access Covers. (4 locations)

(a) Push on end with the arrows in the direction of the arrows.




(b) Lift up on the opposite end while pushing the arrow end. (Fig. 1-1) Use Nylon Panel Removal Tool as needed to pry cover up.



2. Remove Bolts and Bracket.

- (a) Remove 8 Bolts and discard. (4 each side) (Fig. 2-1)
- (b) Remove Bracket and discard. (2 each side) (Fig. 2-1)



3. Install Roof Rack Side Rail


- (a) Position LH side rail on to roof as shown (Fig. 3-1)
 - (1) Identify LH side rail by markings on legs.





(b) Carefully align holes in side rail legs with holes in roof ditch.

- (c) Install the LH roof rack rail leg bolts in sequential order ①,②,③, and ④ using the M8x1.25x49 bolts. (4 required) (Fig. 3-2)
 - (d) Torque bolts to 23 N·m (17 ft·lbf)



Torque: 23 N·m (17 ft·lbf)



(e) Repeat (a)-(d) for the RH roof rack rail.

4. Install Roof Rack Side Rail Leg Covers.



(a) Carefully position locking tabs into side rail (Fig. 4-1).



(b) Press down on cover until 3 outer and 3 inner clips engage the leg (Fig. 4-1).



(c) Confirm that all 4 covers are installed securely (Fig. 4-2).

5. Install Crossbars

(a) Refer to 2013 RAV4 CROSSBAR KIT installation instructions, PT278-42130.
