

 - (a) Open rear hatch and locate the two floor turn-locks. Unlock per the directions imprinted on the locks. (See Fig. 1-1)



(b) Raise floor panel as shown and fold over. (See Fig. 1-2)



(c) Orient sub-floor organizer so the shape matches the under floor compartment. Insert sub-floor organizer into the compartment. (See Fig. 1-3)



(d) Push down gently to seat sub-floor organizer in bottom of compartment as shown.(See Fig. 1-4)


