



1. Installation of Cargo Net Tray

- (a) Open vehicle rear cargo door and locate the Cargo Net Tray mounting points on the passenger side of the cargo compartment.
 (Fig. 1-1)
- (b) Insert right end of front bar (without label) into pocket in passenger side trim panel. (Fig. 1-1)
- (c) Depress left end. (Fig. 1-2)
 - (d) Insert left end of front bar into pocket in driver side trim panel.
- (e) Repeat steps 1(b) 1(d) for Rear Bar (Bar with a caution label).
- (f) Completed installations as shown in Fig 1-3.
