
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



- Safety (eye protection, rechecking torque procedure, etc.).
- Vehicle Disassembly/Reassembly (panel removal, part storage, etc.).
- Electrical Component Disassembly/Reassembly (battery disconnection, connector removal, etc.).

1. Vehicle preparation.



- (a) Part and vehicle surface temperature must be maintained between 65°F and 90°F for optimum installation. Store parts flat at room temperature in a clean dry place.
- (b) Place protect blanket in trunk area to protect from overspray of wetting agent.



- (c) Clean the entire application surface to remove grease and wax. Clean the entire area with a VDC approved cleaner and cleaning method.
- (d) Wipe the cleaned surface with a clean, dry, lint-free cloth.

2. Installation of the Rear Bumper Protector.




- (a) Place part face down on clean flat surface. Remove entire liner. (Fig. 2-1).
- (b) Spray bumper with wetting agent. (Fig. 2-2).





(c) Align the center notch directly below the striker latch opening and the leading edge of the premask along the vertical surface of the bumper being sure not to roll onto the vertical surface. Do not smooth part with hands. (Fig. 2-3).

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- (d) Spray premask with wetting agent. Using long smooth overlapping strokes squeegee from the center outwards of the horizontal section and begin to wrap over bumper. (Fig. 2-4).
 - (1) Do not use excessive force as it may cause creasing of the protector.
- (e) Carefully remove premask paper 180° against itself prior to squeegeeing final wrap area. (Fig. 2-5).
- (f) Using the squeegee, make smooth overlapping downward strokes from the center outwards of the final wrap area or the vertical section. (Fig. 2-6).
- (g) Dry off vehicle with clean lint free rag.

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Checklist - these points MUST be checked to ensure a quality installation.

Check:	Look For:

Proper adhesion – Visual	Look for bubbles, loose and lifting edges.
Proper adhesion – Physical Proper alignment – Cross-Car	With light pressure rub hand over top of part and if crackling sound occurs, resqueegee. If bubbles cannot be worked out to the nearest edge, replace part. Part must be centered within bumper +/-3 mm.
Vehicle Appearance Check After accessory installation and removal of protective cover(s), perform a visual inspection.	Ensure no damage (including scuffs and scratches) was caused during the installation process. (For PPO installations, refer to TMS Accessory Quality Shipping Standard.)

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
