


1. CAUTION: The Ashtray comes with a rubber jacket. The rubber jacket must be used whenever possible to provide the tightest fit. If the Ashtray cannot fit into the cup holder, remove the rubber jacket and store in a safe place. (Fig. 1-1)



- 2. Install the Ashtray (Front Console Cup Holder).
 - (a) Insert the ashtray into the front cup holder of the center console. (Fig. 2-1)
 - (1) NOTE: Actual center Console may differ from what is shown.



- 3. Install the Ashtray (Front Tray Cup Holder).
 - (a) Insert the ashtray into the front tray cup holder. (Fig. 3-1)
 - (1) NOTE: Actual Tray may differ from what is shown.



4. Install the Ashtray (Rear Cup Holder).

- (a) Insert the ashtray into the rear cup holder of the center console. (Fig. 4-1)
 - (1) NOTE: Actual center Console may differ from what is shown.

Procedure

5. Caution.



(a) When not using the ashtray, close the door. While driving, a cigarette butt may drop out of the ashtray if it is left open.



(b) Make sure to put a cigarette butt into the ashtray after completely stubbing out the lighted cigarette and close the door. Failure to do so may cause a fire in the vehicle.



(c) Never put something inflammable such as wastepaper in the ashtray or a fire may be caused in the vehicle.



(d) Never drop the ashtray onto hard ground surface or damage may result.



(e) Never apply excessive force to the ashtray door when it is open or damage may result.



(f) Remove the ashtray slowly. Removing it quickly may cause a cigarette butt drop out of the ashtray.



(g) Open and close a vehicle door with the ashtray door closed. A cigarette butt may drop out of the ashtray if it is left open.
