1. Clean Front Mounting Area



(a) Clean and degrease front body panel where mudguard is to be located with a clean, dry lint free cloth and a VDC approved cleaner.

2. Hardware and Liner Removal





- (a) Remove existing screw locations B and F, do not discard. (Fig. 2-1)
- (b) Remove existing push pin location C and D, discard. (Fig. 2-1)
- (c) Remove liner. (Fig. 2-1)


3. Installation of Spring Clips.





(a) Install spring clip (narrow) over panel edge hole location C and spring clip (large) over panel edge hole-location D with turned up edge on inside of panel. (Fig. 3-1)












4. Installation of Front Mudguard



- (a) Mount mudguard on body panel and install exisiting screw in location B and tighten while holding part up and into body panel. (Fig. 4-1)
- (b) Re-position liner and install existing screw in location F and supplied screws in locations C and D, ensure corner lock tab is engaged over sill panel edge then tighten screws. (Fig. 4-1
- op (c)
- (c) While holding part in position, drill 2.5mm (3/32') centre pilot holes in location A and E. (Fig 4-2)
- STOP
- (d) Install supplied 20mm self tapping screws into locations A and E while holding part into body panel. (Fig. 4-2) DO NO OVERTIGHTEN
- (e) Repeat for other side.


5. Clean Rear Mounting Area

- STOP
- (a) Clean and degrease rear bumper panel where mudguard is to be located with a clean, dry lint free cloth and a VDC approved cleaner.
- (b) Push Pin Removal and Reuse
- (c) Remove existing push pins locations A,B,C and save 1 to reuse in location D. (Fig. 6-1)
- (d) Remove existing push pin location D and discard. (Fig. 6-1)




6. Installation of Spring Clips

(a) Pull liner out and install supplied spring clips (short) over panel edge holes locations A, B and C with turned up edge on inside of panel. (Fig 7-1)



7. Installation Of Mudguards

(a) Mount mudguard and position tab behind liner then reinstall using saved push pin in locationD while holding part up and into body panel.(Fig. 8-1).



(b) While holding mudguard up and into body panel install supplied screws in locationsA, B and C. (Fig. 8-2).

Checklist - these points MUST be checked to ensure a quality installation.

Check:	Look For:
Accessory Function Checks	
Gaps between mudguards and body side	Excessive gaps greater than 1.0 mm.
Vehicle Appearance Check	
After accessory installation and removal of protective cover(s), perform a visual inspection.	Ensure no damage (including scuffs and scratches) was caused during the installation process. (For PPO installations, refer to TMS Accessory Quality Shipping Standard.)
